Five members are up for reelection each year

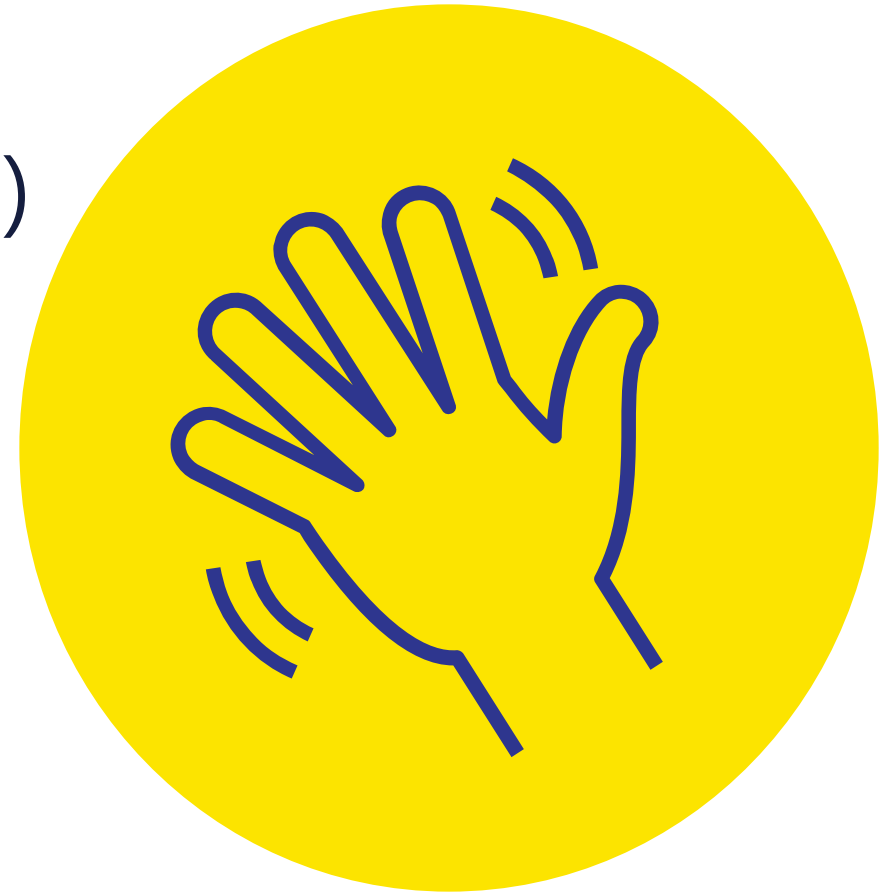

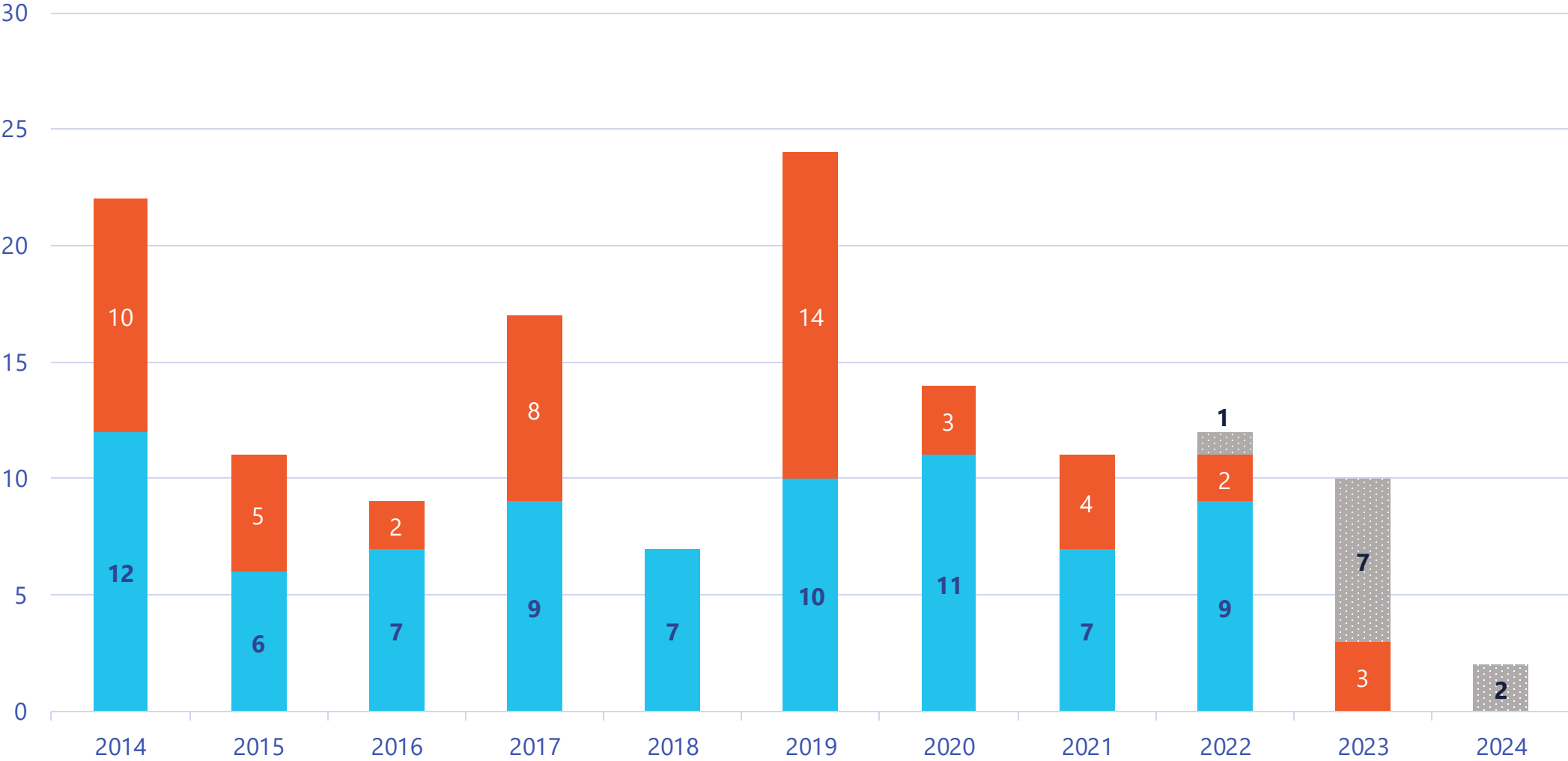
