Clarification of reference to 8.2 in 8.3

Current Text (24 January 2020)

Problem Statement:

Section 8.3 refers to transfers completed under 8.2 when it actually intends to reference addresses received through transfers under section 8.2.

Policy Statement:

Change the last sentence of the second bullet of section 8.3:

The source entity must not have received a transfer, allocation, or assignment of IPv4 number resources from ARIN for the 12 months prior to the approval of a transfer request. This restriction does not include 8.2 transfers.

to

The source entity must not have received a transfer, allocation, or assignment of IPv4 number resources from ARIN for the 12 months prior to the approval of a transfer request. Number resources received as the result of an 8.2 transfer are out of scope for the purposes of this restriction.

Summary (Staff Understanding)

Staff understands that this Editorial Change clarifies language in 8.3. to specifically refer to addresses received through transfers under section 8.2. as opposed to the transfers themselves.
