Overview

- Two active suggestions were included in the Open Suggestion Review period, part of the recently revised ARIN Consultation and Suggestion Process., The ARIN community was asked to review the following suggestions and on the <u>arin-consult</u> mailing list:
- 1. Comment on the merits of each (eg. Worth doing, not worth the effort, must have, etc.)
- 2. Rank them in order of preference for potential implementation.
- We are soliciting here at ARIN 31 to get feedback.



Open Suggestion and Consultation

2013.5 Provide WHOIS-RWS results in JSONP For Ease of 3rd-Part Application Development

- ARIN will add the Access-Control-Allow-Origin header setting to enable this functionality as it is the best standardized approach to providing these types of services.
- Estimated staff effort to implement: \$21,000 in engineering costs, plus communications efforts.



Open Suggestion and Consultation

2013.4 Change Whois output for certain /8 records

- Currently part of a Community Consultation

- Two possible approaches:
 - Continue to show the majority RIR when someone looks up an IP address outside of the ARIN region
 - Stop showing the ERX /8 record, which fixes the rwhois referral problem
- Estimated staff effort to implement: \$26,000 in engineering costs, plus communications efforts.
