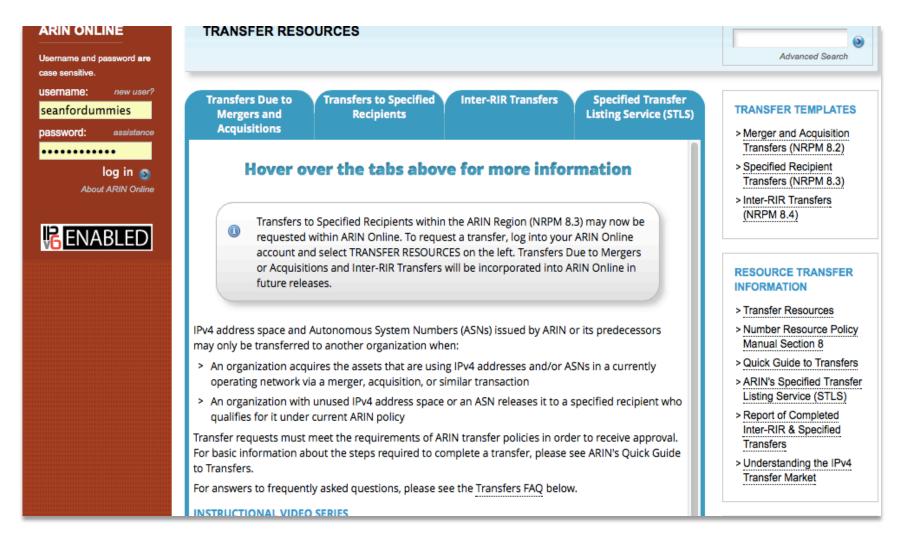

OVERVIEW

As part of the process of requesting number resources from ARIN, there is often a need for the organization making the request to supply documentation to demonstrate how the request meets the specific requirements outlined by policy. To help make this process easier, we provide below several types of documentation that may be required along with examples you can download. The examples are not intended to demonstrate how to meet specific policy requirements, but help to show the best format for the documentation to be processed as quickly and efficiently as possible.

The examples are in Microsoft Office formats, but other file formats may be submitted. If you do not have the software that is capable of displaying these formats, iit may be necessary to download and install either a "viewer" or other software that is capable of opening these formats. Some possibilities include:

- > Microsoft Excel Viewer [Windows Only]
- > Microsoft Word Viewer [Windows Only]
- > Microsoft Office Online

END-USER ASSIGNMENTS

This example demonstrates the type and format of data ARIN is seeking when corresponding with organizations that have made a request for an assignment (also known as an "end-user request"). Requesting organizations should include the utilization information for each previous assignment and a subnet mapping for the requested
