“The Policy Development Process charges the member-elected ARIN Advisory Council (AC) as the primary facilitators of the process”

AC Role in the PDP

1. Work with author on proposals
Ensure clarity and valid problem statement
2. Work on Draft Policies
Gather input from the community and present to community
3. Work on Recommended Draft Policies
Find to be fair and impartial, technically sound, and supported by community; recommend adoption, present to community
4. Review Last Call
5. Recommend to the Board of Trustees

Policy Work



- 2016 so far
 - Advanced 2 Recommended Drafts to the ARIN Board 2015-5, 2015-11
 - Abandoned 1 Draft Policy 2015-6
 - 1 new proposals turned into Draft 2016-1
 - One PPC at NANOG 66 in San Diego
- 5 items currently on our docket

Policy Work

Result of previous Policy Experience Report

- Issuing IPv4 prefixes longer than a /24
 - 2014-22 was abandoned 4/15
 - Discussions continue, but limited support to change existing language
- IPv4 address block swapping
 - Staff requested feedback on current practices regarding IP block swaps when transferring networks
 - Current approach should continue
- 8.2 Transfer “return” language
 - Discussions resulted in an AC request to staff in March to initiate the editorial change process

Additional Work

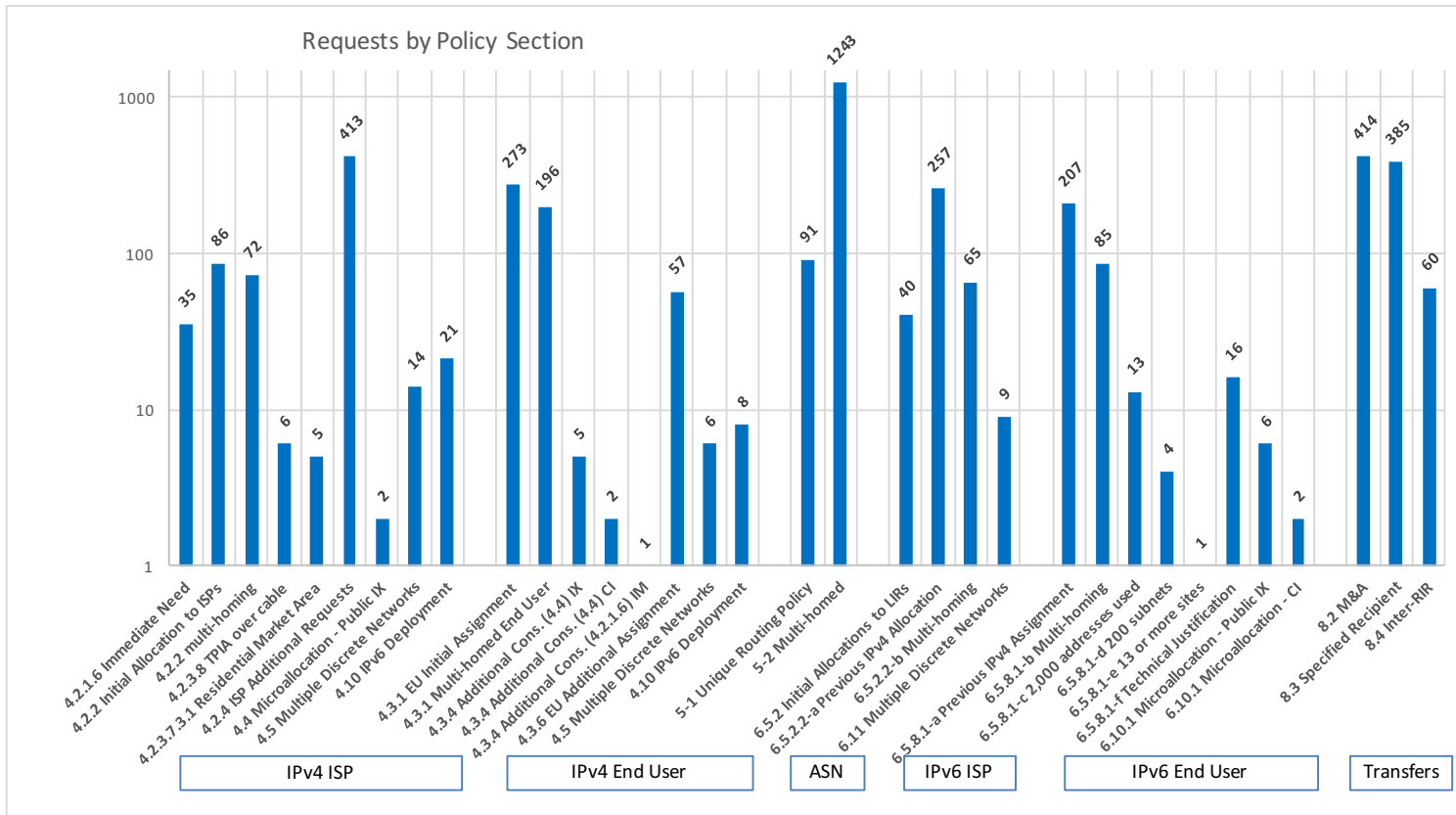


- Clarify and Improve PPC Format
 - What is a Public Policy Consultation (PPC)
 - *“An open public discussion held by ARIN of Internet number resource policy that provides for the contemporaneous interaction and polling of in-person and remote participants. These consultations may be held at ARIN's Public Policy Meetings and at other related forums as approved by the ARIN Board of Trustees.”*
 - Proposals can advance or be abandoned as a result of a NANOG PPC the same as they can at an ARIN PPC
 - A partial docket is being discussed at a NANOG PPC as a result of previous feedback
 - AC has no plans for PPC at NANOG 67 in June
 - “Right tool for the job” The AC will request a NANOG PPC session when feedback is needed, or a proposal's urgency requires more immediate action
