- New Fee Schedule – 1 July 2016

- Major benefits
  - Adjusts all IPv6 resource tiers “down” so that parties obtaining IPv6 blocks are less likely to see registration services category change
  - Allows end-users to pay for registry services by opting for registration services plan (same schedule as ISPs), thus paying based on total resources rather than per object – also includes ARIN membership
