

AC Role in the PDP



- Work with author on proposals to ensure clarity and valid problem statement
- Work on Draft Policies
 - Gather input from the community and present to community
- Work on Recommended Draft Policies until they are:
 - Fair and impartial
 - Technically sound
 - Supported by community
- 4. Recommend adoption, present to community
- Send to Last Call and review comments
- 6. Recommend to the Board of Trustees


2016 Policy Work



- Completed
 - Sent 2015-3, 2015-5, 2015-11 to the Board for adoption
 - Abandoned 2 Draft Policies
 - One editorial update for the "return" language in 8.2 M&A transfers
- New submissions
 - 7 Proposals submitted- 5 recommended, 1 draft, 1 Proposal
- 1 Public Policy Consultation (PPC) held @NANOG 66
- 2 Public Policy Meetings (PPMs)
- Current docket: 9 items (7 RDP, 1 DP, 1 Proposal)

Takeaways from the Policy Experience Report

- NRPM Section 5: AS Number Policy
 - 30 day interpretation of "immediate" is too constrictive
 - Do we want to clarify "immediate" as something different from the current 30 day interpretation?
- NRPM 4.2.3.6: Reassignments to multihomed downstream customers
 - Organizations cannot qualify for a /24 and cannot get one from upstream provider
 - Please let the AC know if you are experiencing this issue, and whether 2016-4 would address your concerns
