Staff and Legal Review (August 2016)



- Staff Understanding:
 - This draft policy removes all remaining HD-Ratio language from the NRPM. It is intended registration staff not use the HD-Ratio method for verifying IPv6 utilization or determining IPv6 block size approvals.

Staff and Legal Review (continued)



- Staff Comments:
 - Aligns with current staff practice. Staff uses Section 6 policies to determine initial IPv6 qualification size and utilization.
 - Default community network IPv6 requestor classification is end-user, with an option to subscribe to a Registration Services Plan.

- Legal Assessment:
 - The policy does not appear to create any material legal issue.
