Chartered by NRO EC, and formed in 2016

- Based on CRISP team recommendations
 - The Internet Number Community proposal to the IANA Stewardship Coordination Group (ICG) called for the establishment of an IANA Numbering Services Review Committee (IANA RC).



Role

The Review Committee's function is to advise and assist the NRO EC in its periodic review of the service level of the IANA Numbering Services provided to the Internet Number Community.

The Review Committee is a tool for the Internet Number Community to evaluate and review performance of the IANA Numbering Services provided. Review Committee will ensure community involvement and will support and enhance the multistakeholder model in a transparent, open, and bottom up process to ensure that the number resources component of the IANA operations meets the

needs and expectations of its customers, namely the Internet numbers community.
