

- ASN 27648 28671 received from IANA 26592 - 26623 received from ARIN (transition) Total ASN - 1056






200/8 DISTRIBUTION PER COUNTRY






IPv4 /24 ALLOCATED PER MONTH






IPv4 ALLOCATIONS PER MONTH






ASN DISTRIBUTION PER COUNTRY



Total amount 782 ASN




ASN ASSIGNMENT PER MONTH





IPv6 ALLOCATION IN LACNIC




