Problem Statement

- * Simple reassignment registrations do not have POC information
- * Complaints/questions from community
- * Blacklist from RFC-Ignorant

Which Solution?

- * Educate community to conduct subsequent query
- * Change WHOIS display to default upstream POC data for all reassign-simple
- * Do not display simple-reassign in WHOIS

Educate Community

* Pro

- ▶ No modification to WHOIS necessary

* Cons

- ▶ No clear method to educate community
- ▶ No guarantee that it will work
- ▶ Can success be measured?
- ▶ Subsequent queries to WHOIS increase load

Default Upstream POCs

* Pro

- ▶ All network records will have POC information

* Con

- ▶ Does not provide additional information
- ▶ Significant engineering effort
- ▶ Increased database size

Don't Display In WHOIS

* Pro

- ▶ All network records will have POC information
- ▶ Reduce the total size of WHOIS
- ▶ Increase data integrity

* Con

- ▶ WHOIS will not provide utilization information
- ▶ May not be able to determine end-user
