AC Procedure Changes

- At least two AC members in charge of each policy area
- Keep policies moving or abandon them.
- New procedure for election of AC chair

- 2003-1 and 2003-2 (Network Abuse)
 - Proposals abandoned as-is
 - AC members deciding how to proceed on requiring abuse contact to be set and POC data verification procedure and ramifications.
- 2003-3 (Residential Privacy)
 - AC members deciding how to proceed on general DB changes and privacy issues.

- 2003-4 (IPv6 Policy Changes)
 - ARIN IPv6 working group will consider the proposal
 - AC members will participate in the process to keep the whole AC informed of progress.
- 2003-5 (Rwhois Server Requirements)
 - Final call pending, with minor changes
 - AC members will monitor final call

 - Proposal abandoned as-is
 - Feedback incorporated with 2002-3

 - AC members will work on developing a general whois AUP based on current bulk whois AUP

 - AC members will work on a new version to use as a strawman for inter-RIR design team towards a global policy
