# What ICANN Does Not Do


- Financial transactions

# **Ongoing Work**

- 3 year MOU signed with DOC in September 2003
- Exploring New Registry Services
  - Internationalized Domain Names (IDN)
    - Beginning to be implemented by ccTLDs and gTLDs
  - Sitefinder, and other services
    - Review underway by the Security and Stability Committee
    - Process initiated in Generic Names Supporting Organization to develop a policy regarding introducing new Registry services

- Workshops on WHOIS issues held at the June 2003 ICANN meeting, discussions continuing
- World Summit on the Information Society (WSIS)
  - ITU initiative
  - ICANN participating in discussions
- WIPO-2

  - Joint working group composed of participants from GNSO, GAC, and ALAC
