


 Exactly two years ago, the ARIN's Board approved an economic contribution to support LACNIC start up.






Budget Evolution





Policies

 6 new policies approved in 2003.
- New PDP try to improve the participation, to facilitate the submission of proposals and to clarify the role of each one (the list, the forum, the board, the assembly)
- One priority of the staff this year is to facilitate the soon implementation of the new PDP



Cooperation

- During 2003 LACNIC continued working under the cooperation agreements with the Brazilian and Mexican National Registries. (NIRs).
- Still receiving important cooperation from NIC Brazil.
- LACNIC is starting to assume some tasks and the costs involved on them.
- Cooperation will continue for a long time based on new schemes.



Special Projects

- FRIDA Program <u>www.programafrida.net</u>
 - It is an joint initiative of LACNIC, The Institute for the Connectivity in The Americas (ICA) and the International Development Research Center – IDRC (Canada)
 - Supported by ISOC and the GKP.
 - Small grants program to support research in ICTs in Latin America.
 - U\$S 500 k in total.
- Agreement signed with ISC
 - There is also a contribution from ICA.
 - The objective is to setup 7 anycast copies in Latin America.
 - LACNIC Investment around U\$S 150 K.



LACNIC - NRO

- Negotiation of the new ASO MoU
- Spending more energies in RIRs coordination through the NRO.
- Support to AFRINIC
- Preparations to host the secretariat next year.
- Dedicating resources to Joint Whois project.
- Joint participation in international forums. (WSIS and others)
- Participating in ICANN's budget discussions on behalf of NRO.



LACNIC VI

- Very successful.
- 122 people from 24 countries (17 countries from the region)
- LACNIC hosted meetings of other organizations (LACTLD, CLARA, eCOM-LAC) and there were joint activities.
