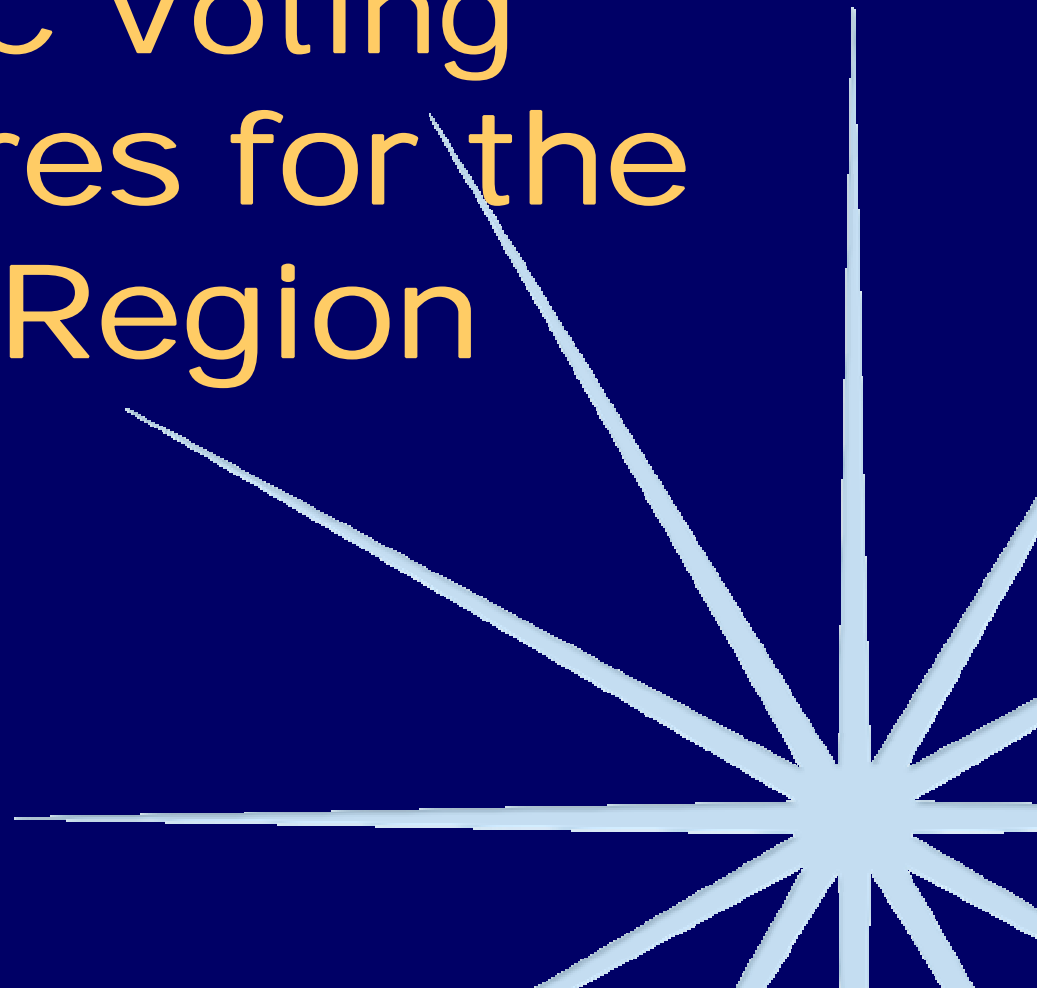

Member Voting Procedures

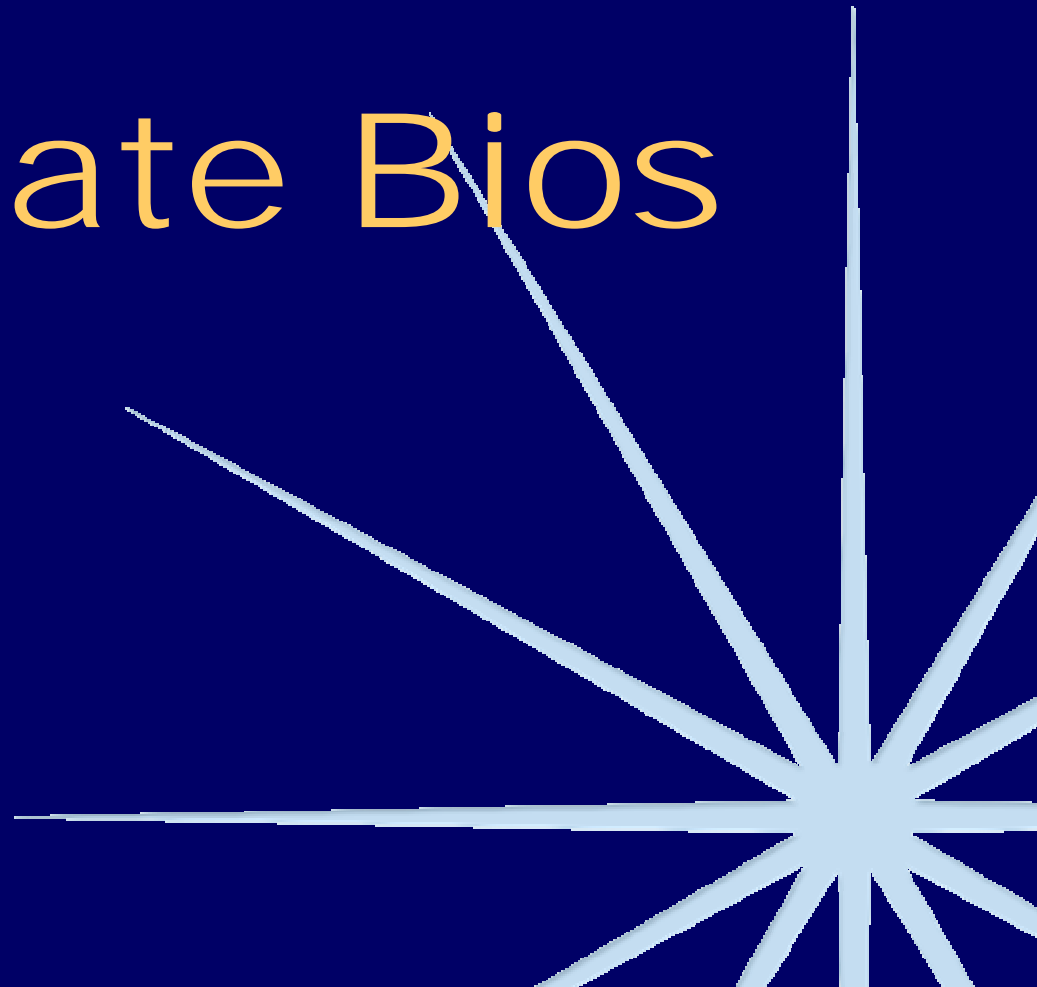
- ★ Online voting opened Oct. 13 for ARIN General Members in good standing
