#### Policy Proposal 2007-8 Legal Assessment\*

**Comment:** 

"We are reviewing this policy. In the past, we have advised that transfer issues create the risk of litigation when ARIN refuses to transfer resources. In view of the nonuniform RSAs, including some that have different dispute mechanisms, ARIN should handle any changes regarding transfer as a policy, rather than amending the RSA. ARIN should consider amending the proposed policy so as to provide, in sum or substance, that if a party does not obtain the transferred resources within a certain period of time, e.g., 30 days or 45 days, then it would have the right to initiate a dispute in the forum specified under the current RSA or the RSA that governs the party."
