




### **LACNIC Membership Evolution**

  - constantly perfecting an impartial, participative and transparent selfregulation model,
  - the adoption and promotion of technological advancements and standards within the industry,
  - strengthening the relationships with the main stakeholders of the Internet within the region,
  - the development of regional capabilities through training and the transmission of Internet-related technology.



#### Other projects (big focus in development)

- +Raices
  - Three anycast root servers (Chile, Argentina, Venezuela).
  - 2 new root servers coming (Panama, Ecuador)
  - Looking for partners in the Caribbean region.
- FRIDA Program
  - Partnership among LACNIC, IDRC from Canada and ISOC.
  - Small grants program for funding research projects
  - Total amount for this phase: US\$ 650.000
  - Next call for projects: this week!



#### Other actions

- Supporting and organizing different meetings around the region.
  - Internet day, Argentina.
  - Caribbean Ministerial meeting in Anguilla. (CTU)
  - IXP promotion meeting in Central America (w/CISCO)
- Traffic Measure
  - Very important issue for the region as interconnection costs is one of the most sensible topics.
  - Working in a joint project with PCH
  - Announcements expected for LACNIC X
