Policy Proposal 2007-9

Description

- Changes the immediate need policy by reducing the minimum allocation from a fixed /20 to ARIN's current minimum allocation as defined elsewhere in the NRPM, and sets the maximum allocation size at a /16. Also defines a 30 day utilization window of the IP address space.
