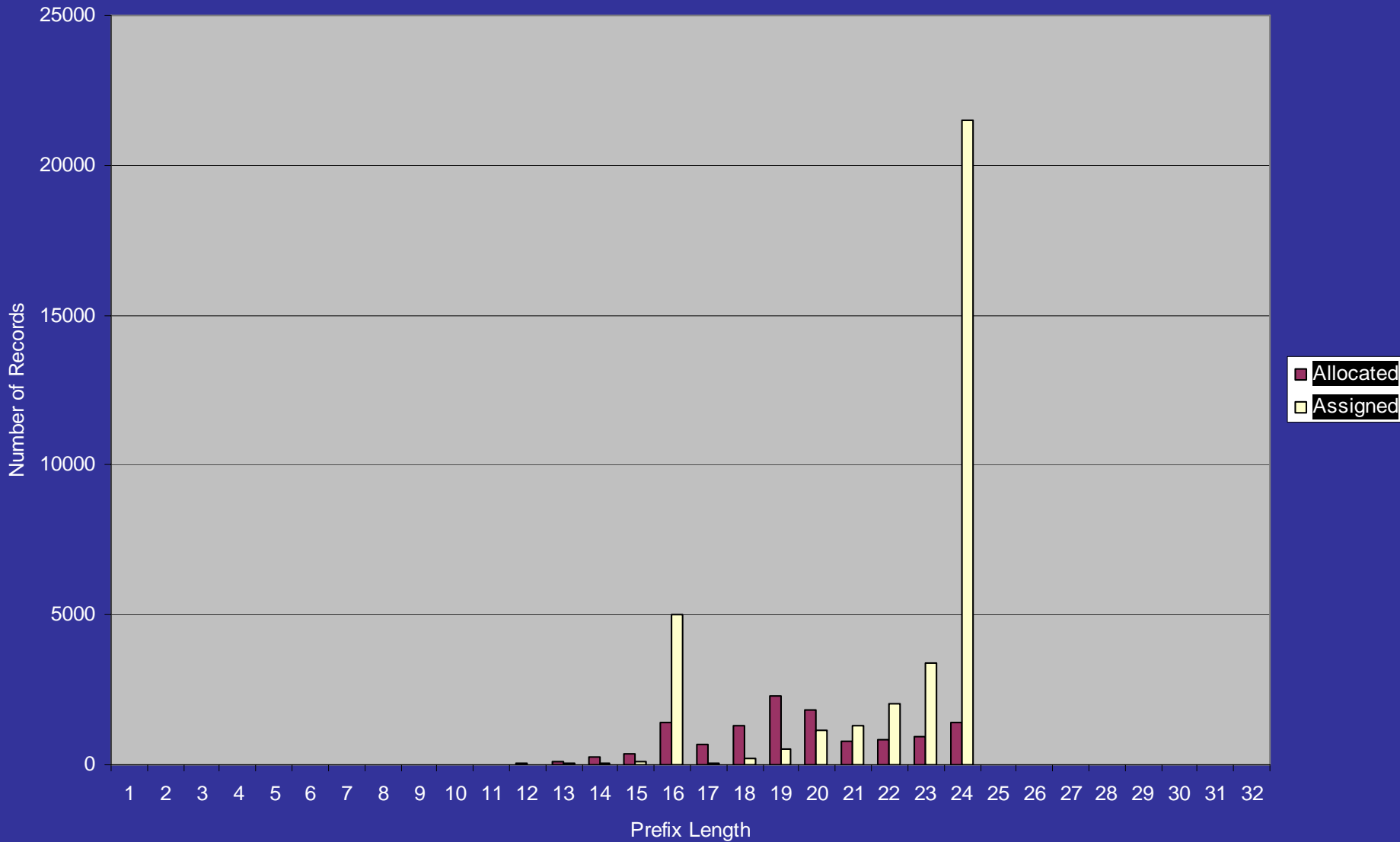
# Discussion Starter

    - All data is taken in CIDR form, in some cases one “record” has two CIDR entries:

NetRange:        73.0.0.0 – 73.191.255.255

CIDR:            73.0.0.0/9, 73.128.0.0/10

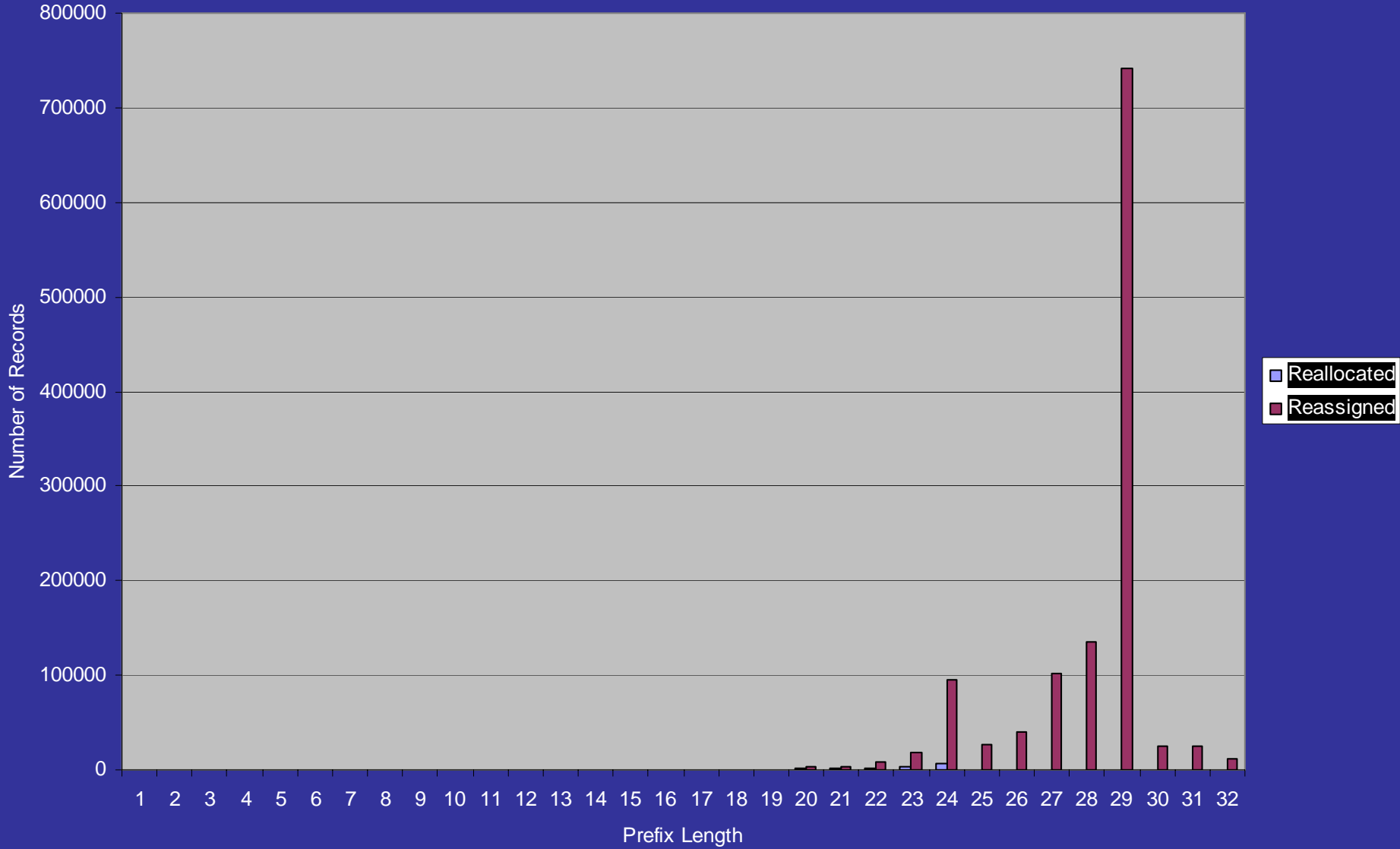
