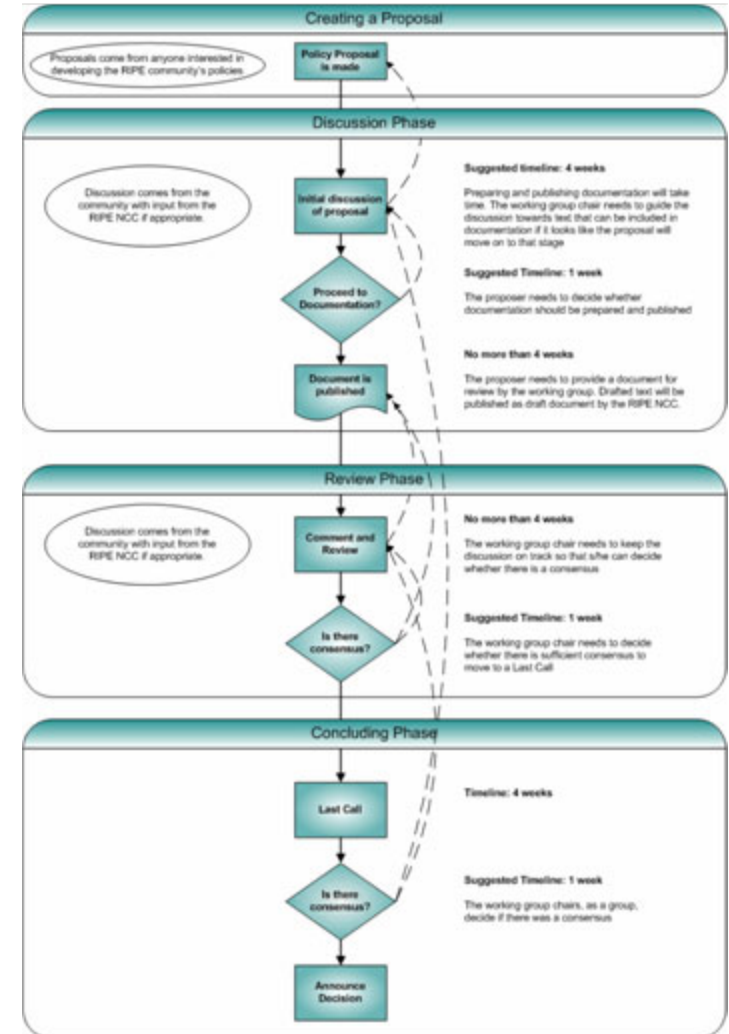

Training

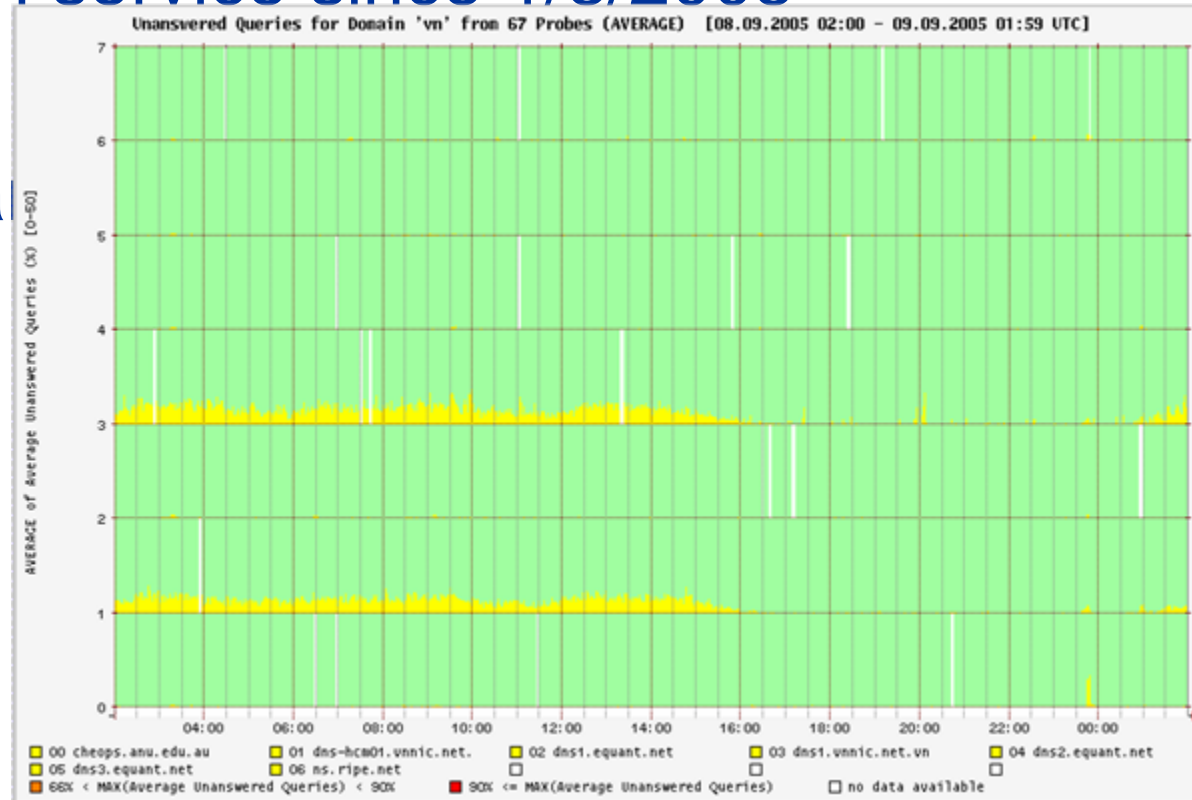
- E-learning
