

Policy Proposal 2007-22 Staff Comments*

- 1. In addition to changing the time period from 6 months to one year, this policy removes the qualification criteria that a member be a subscriber with a direct ARIN allocation. If an organization has no allocation history with ARIN, it makes it difficult to reliably verify and evaluate a 12 month projection.
- ARIN staff suggests changing the section name of NRPM 4.2.4.4 from "Six months" to "Twelve months".
