General Meeting, May 2008

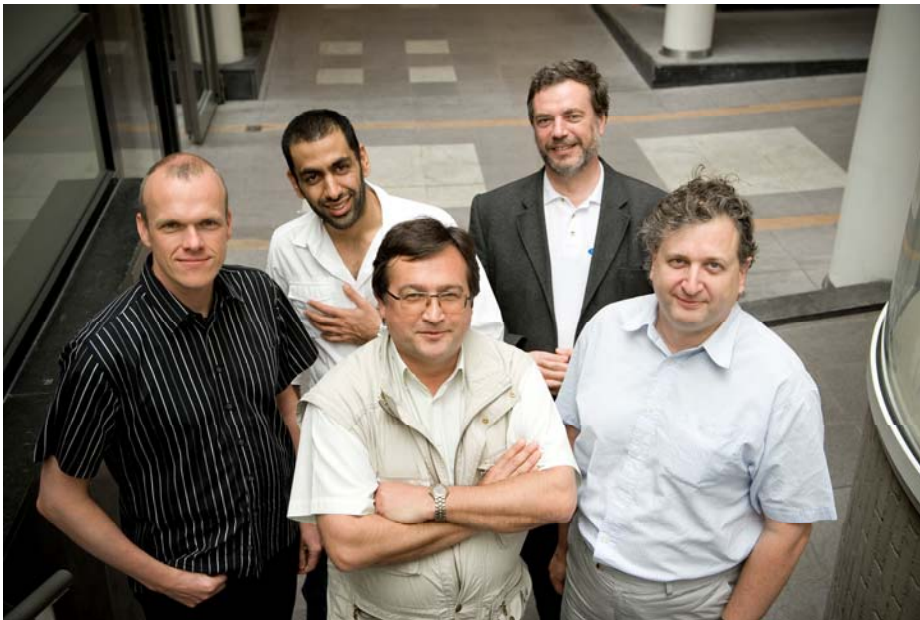
- Good Attendance

 - Trusted Source of Data: Hardening Registry, Reporting Tools
 - Number Resource Lifecycle Management: Allocation, Auditing, Reclamation, Certification

- Plan to deploy in 2009

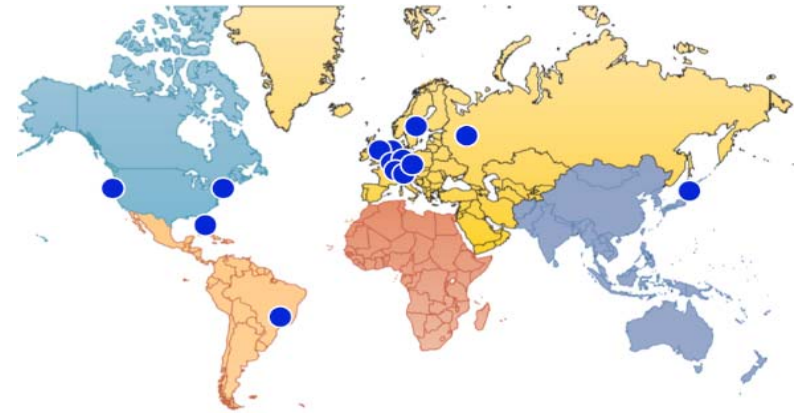


Policy Development Support
