

Multicast

- Developing XML format for the IPv4 and IPv6 registries with the IETF MBONED WG
- draft-ietf-mboned-rfc3171bis approaching publication

AS Numbers

- Worked with NRO to update the AS Numbers registry to reflect the authoritative Whois server for each AS Number
- One block of 16-bit AS Numbers allocated since the global policy was ratified by the ICANN board
- ► Expect to be instructed to update the AS Numbers registry to use ASPLAIN notation for 32-bit AS Numbers as per draft-ietf-idr-as-representation-01.txt
