

Whois Statistics








IRR Whois Statistics

Queries








Origin AS V. Route Views

Lame Lessons Learned

- Had a Policy Experience Report Before ARIN XXII
- Consensus of the room was to keep lame going
- Very conservative on removals
 - Lots of surprise by holders despite numerous email notifications
 - Turn on after the fact
 - Significant potential for negative impact
- Methodology changes
 - Making less strict
 - PTR checks along with SOA checks
 - Tussling with authoritative response


ARIN Online

- Active accounts = 5,381 (registered and confirmed, with active status)
- Active accounts with a profile = 4,930 (customer logged in and created a profile)
- Confirmed POC links = 4,872
- **POC** requests = 2,697
- **ORG** requests = 1,441



Quality Assurance

- Every update working through QA
- Minimizing the "oops" factor
- ARIN Online is a significant effort
 - Broad browser support
 - Full regression testing

Requirements


- Testable systems
