


LACNIC

- Staff increasing every year (22 at the moment)




Membership evolution

- New process (PDP) since last year introducing expedite process.

- Nicolás Antoniello (Uruguay) elected in May 2009.



Policy Under discussion:

- Ratified by board, to be implemented shortly:
 - LAC-2009-01 Global Policy for the allocation of IPv4 Blocks to Regional Internet Registries
 - LAC-2009-02 IPv6 Allocations to ISPs or LIR with previous IPv4 allocations
 - LAC-2009-03 ASPLAIN notation for 32-bit ASNs
 - LAC-2009-05 Allocation of 16-bit only ASNs
 - LAC-2009-06 Resource Recovery
 - LAC-2009-07 Modification of the minimum initial IPv4 allocation size for ISPs to a /22

Last-call (*):

 LAC-2009-08 Internet Assigned Numbers Authority (IANA) Policy for Allocation of ASN Blocks (ASNs) to Regional Internet Registries

- Working on the organization of several workshop for the IGF.


