Current IPv4 Inventory

- **4.87 /8 equivalents** in the pool of “available addresses”
- **4.82 /16 equivalents** in the “RRH” bucket
(RRH = returned, revoked, held)
- **1 /10 reserved**
 - For NRPM 4.10 “Dedicated IPv4 block to facilitate IPv6 Deployment”

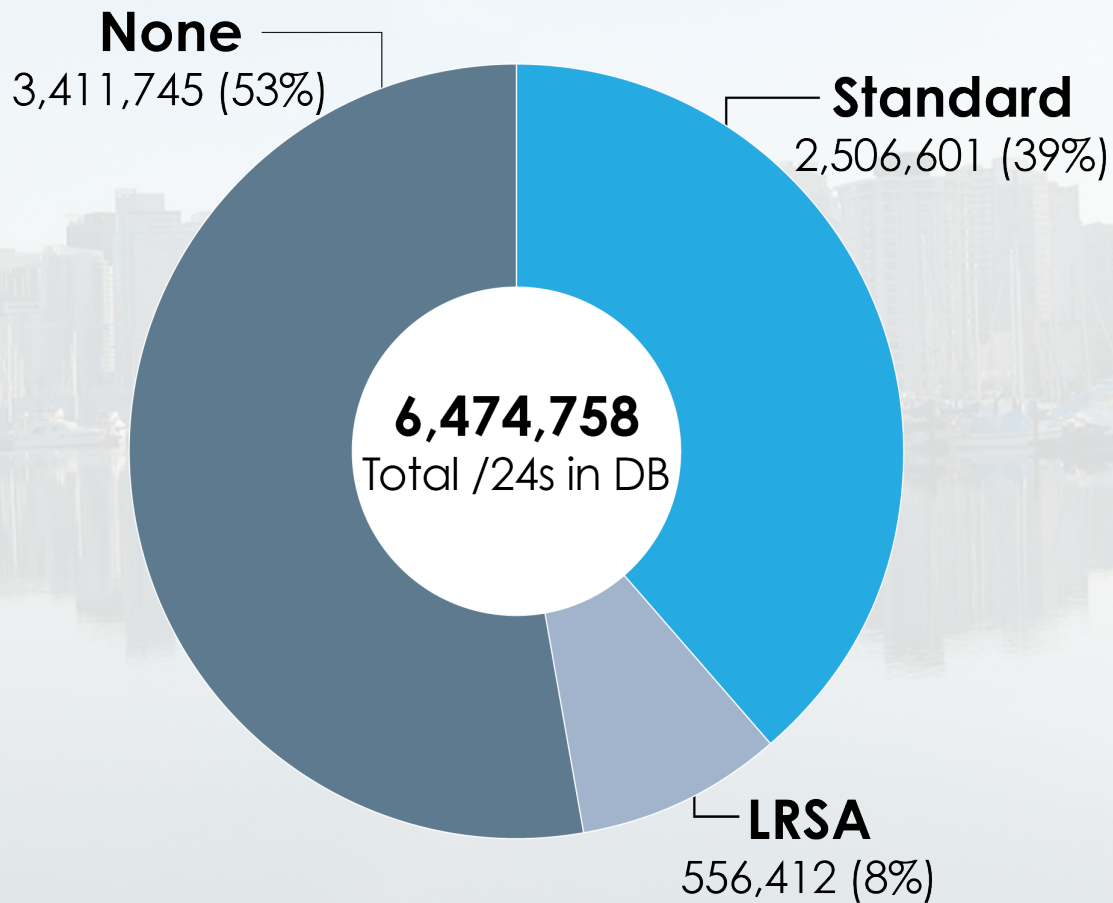

Resource Classification Project Stats

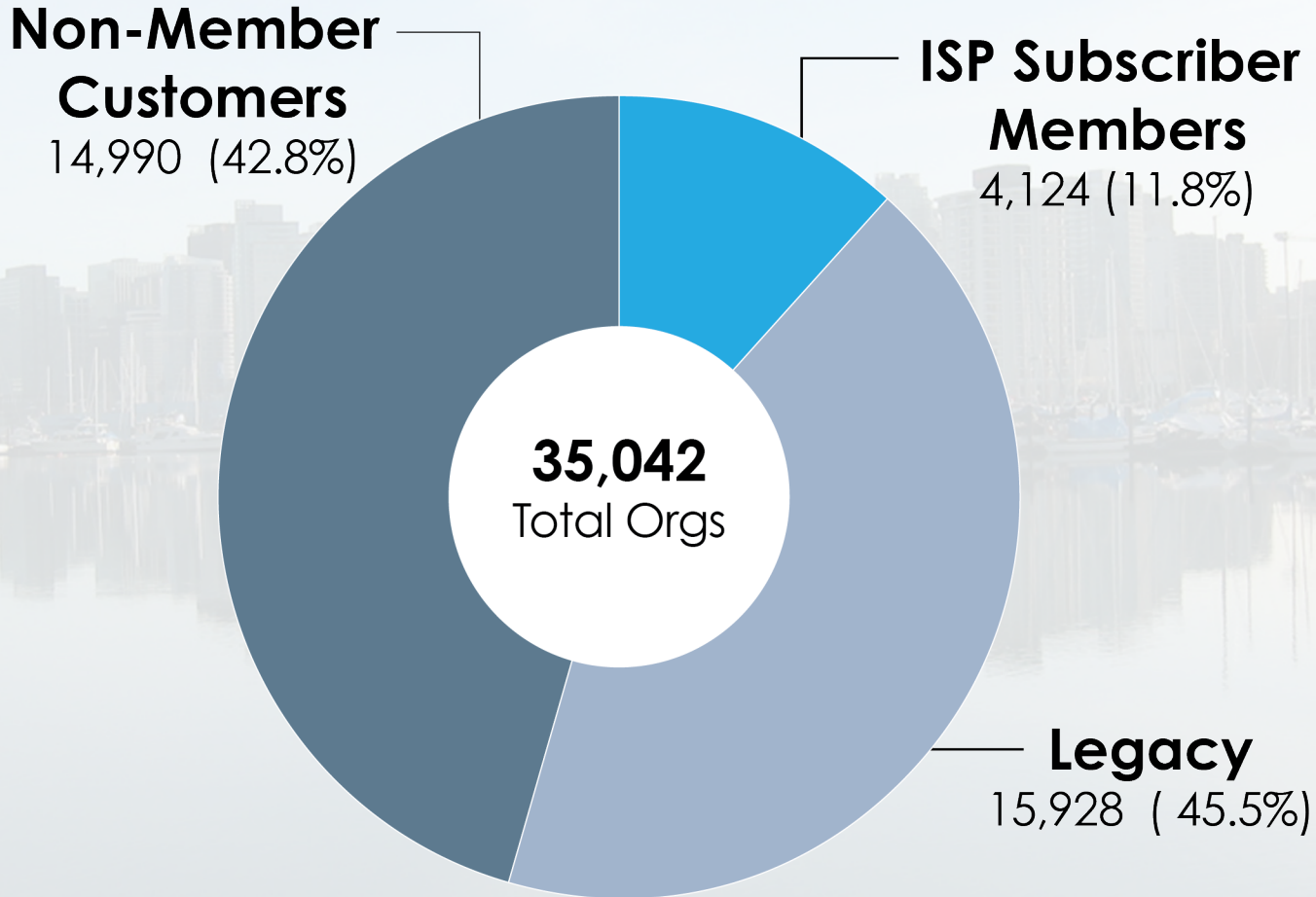
- **47,103** total network registration records in ARIN's db
