- Download via RESTful URL.
- Must still sign Bulk Whois AUP

 - For templates, tickets will now have status.

 - Does not have to be ARIN Online email address




Managing Nameservers

- Online management of your DNS data.
- Necessary for the switch from "Network-based" nameserver management to "Delegation-based"
 - Change DNS specifics on a perdelegation boundary basis.
