
NTIA IPv6 Workshop

- US Government announced new guidance for US Federal agencies, including:
 - Upgrade external facing servers and to operationally use native IPv6 by the end of FY 2012
 - Upgrade internal client applications to operationally use native IPv6 by the end of FY 2014
 - Designate an IPv6 Transition Manager by 30 October
 - Ensure agency procurements of networked IT comply with FAR IPv6 requirements


