
- Global Policy and Proposal Activity
 - **POLICY: Internet Assigned Numbers Authority (IANA) Policy for Allocation of ASN Blocks to Regional Internet Registries**
 - Ratified by ICANN Board on 21 September 2010
 - **PROPOSAL: [GPP-IPv4-2010] Global policy for IPv4 allocations by the IANA post exhaustion**
 - Adopted ARIN, abandoned APNIC, withdrawn RIPE, under discussion at AfriNIC and LACNIC
 - Unlikely to advance
 - **PROPOSAL: [GPP-IPv4-2011] Global Policy for Post Exhaustion: IPv4 Allocation Mechanisms by the IANA**
 - Last call APNIC, under discussion ARIN, LACNIC, RIPE.

- [GPP-IPv4-2010] Global Policy Proposal for the Allocation of IPv4 by IANA Post Exhaustion**
 - Summary: IANA will accept return of address space into a reclamation pool, IANA reallocation to RIRs based upon need.
 - Status: *Still under discussion at some RIRs; however, the proposal is unlikely to advance since it has been abandoned by two RIRs.*
