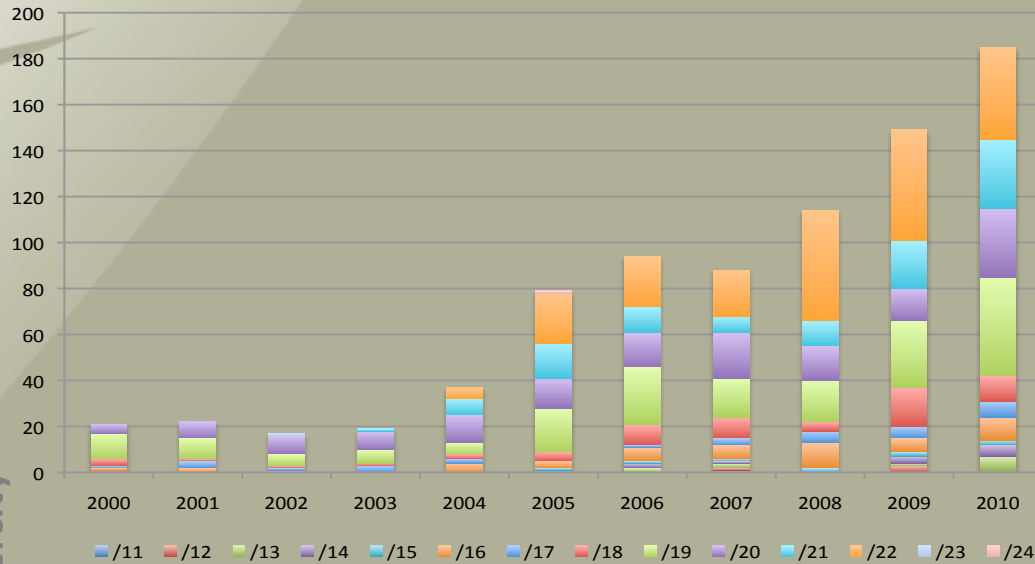
AfriNIC in 2011

- Budget of **\$2,8 Million** in 2011
- **8,308,992** IP addresses allocated in 2010
- **54** new IPv6 allocations in 2010
- **131** New Member (100%)
- **2** Policy meetings and 3 new policies adopted (reached consensus)
- More than **200** travels handled to participated to more than **30** events around the world.
- Run **11** training sessions in 11 countries in Africa.

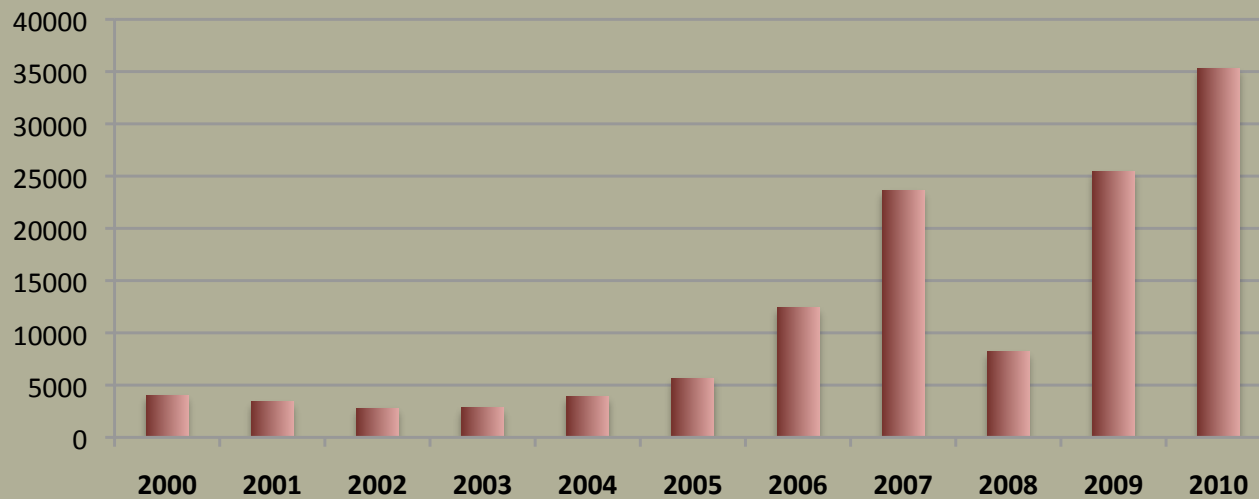

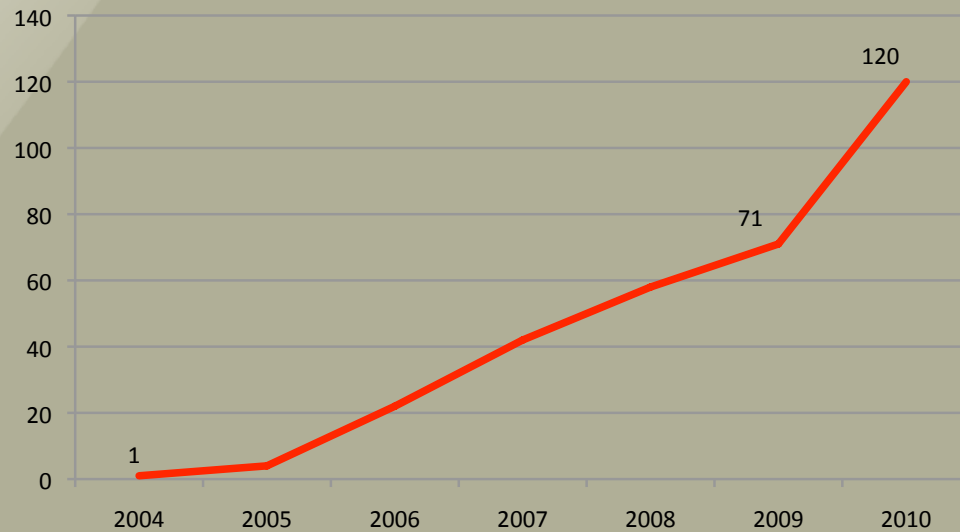


IPv4 Allocations Growth (/24)

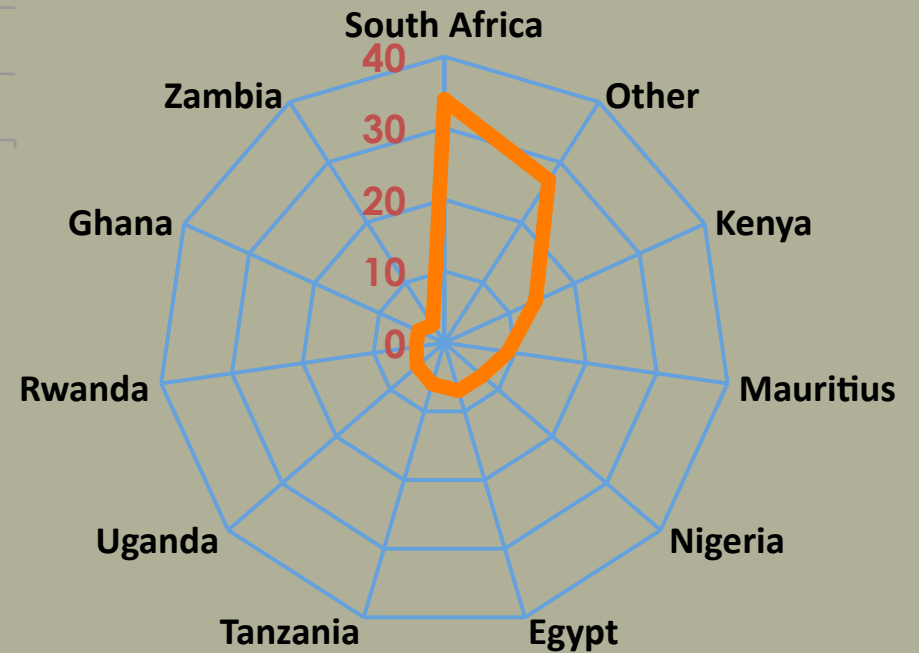


IPv6 allocation
