# Terms

- **Allocate**
  - to issue number resources to ISPs (LIRs) for internal networks and for further sub-delegation to customers
- **Assign**
  - to issue number resources to end-users for internal networks only
- **Multi-homed**
  - connectivity to more than one ISP and the same prefix announced by at least two of those ISPs

# IPv4 – Initial Allocation to ISPs

<b>Policy Type</b>	<b>Minimum Size</b>	<b>Criteria</b>
<b>Standard</b>	<b>/20</b>	<b>/20 (in total) reassigned from upstream(s)</b>
<b>Multi-homed (or intent to multi-home)</b>	<b>/22</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● <b>/23 reassigned from upstream(s)</b></li><li>● <b>Must renumber</b></li></ul>

# IPv4 – Additional Allocations to ISPs

- **Criteria**
  - 80% efficient use of most recent allocation
  - Returned space to upstream (if applicable)
  - Must show reassignment information
  - Based on three month need (12 months if subscriber has been an ARIN member for longer than a year)

# IPv4 – Assignments to End-users

<b>Policy Type</b>	<b>Minimum Assignment</b>	<b>Criteria</b>
<b>Standard</b>	<b>/20</b>	<b>Show 25% utilization plan now and 50% within 1 year</b>
<b>Multi-homed (or intent to multi-home)</b>	<b>/22</b>	<b>Show 25% utilization plan now and 50% within 1 year</b>

# Immediate Need

- Criteria
  - Provide justification to show address space will be used within 30 days
    - **Examples of justification**
      - Signed customer contracts
      - Network topology plan
      - Network deployment schedule
      - Equipment receipts
      - Connectivity contracts
- /16 is largest block issued under this policy

# Micro-Allocation

- Criteria
  - Must be critical Internet infrastructure provider to qualify
    - public exchange points, core DNS service providers (e.g. ICANN-sanctioned root, gTLD, and ccTLD operators), RIRs, and ICANN
  - Exchange point operators must provide justification including: connection policy, location, other participants (minimum of two total), ASN, and contact information
- Allocation size no longer than /24 (v4) or /48 (v6)



# IPv6 – Initial Allocation to ISPs

- Criteria
  - Be an LIR (an ISP), and not an end site
  - Plan to provide IPv6 connectivity to organizations and route the aggregate prefix
  - Plan to make at least 200 assignments to customers within five years OR be a well known ISP in the ARIN region
- Minimum allocation is /32

# IPv6 – Additional Allocation to ISPs

- Criteria
  - ISP must achieve acceptable utilization of its allocated space; measured in terms of /56 assignments using the HD Ratio of .94
- Example
  - One /32 has 16,777,216 /56s
  - 6,183,533 /56s would have to be assigned in order to request more IP address space

# IPv6 Assignments to End-Users

- Criteria
  - not be an IPv6 LIR; and
  - qualify for an IPv4 assignment or allocation from ARIN under the IPv4 policy currently in effect
- Initial assignment size is /48

# ASN

- Criteria
  - Be a multi-homed site (or intend to multi-home)
  - OR
  - Have a unique routing policy
